Learning and Complex Behavior can be used as a textbook for either undergraduate or graduate students and as a general reference for those interested in the implications of basic biobehavioral science for human behavior. To assist students, detailed Study Questions have been prepared that are coordinated with the chapter headings. These questions can be printed directly from the web browser or copied and pasted into a word-processing program for reformatting prior to printing. The Study Questions supplement the more general questions and technical terms found at the end of each chapter.

For a focus on the fundamentals with either undergraduate or graduate students, instructors may omit some portions of the text.

A Sample Syllabus link is also provided with suggested omissions.

The web page for a chapter may also contain supplemental and updated material coordinated with the topics treated in Learning and Complex Behavior.
